

Colonial Women Rummage Collection Guidelines

Because of concerns about COVID-19, Colonial Women is hosting a rummage collection rather than the usual sale. The goal is to raise \$1,000, which means about 5,000 pounds of items! Savers will pay us by the pound for good quality items.

Goal – To reach the goal we need about 2,500 pounds of soft goods and 2,500 pounds of hard goods (although soft goods are preferred). To reach that requires:

- 250 13-gallon white trash bags of soft goods
- 200 boxes of hard goods

Amount that has been reported collected by members to date:

- 21 bags of soft goods
- 5 boxes of Hard goods
- 6 boxes of books

Collection – April 11 starting at 9:30 a.m.

Bring your items on Sunday, April 11 beginning at 9:30 a.m. Everything will be loaded directly into a truck and taken to Savers the following day. Start collecting your items now so we have plenty of pounds to deliver to Savers in April. Nothing will be stored at the church.

Soft Goods – Place in 13 gallon kitchen bags (white) please. Label Soft Goods

- clothing - adult and children/infant
- bath items, towels/shower curtains
- bedding - sheets, blankets, pillows/comforters/bed skirts/pillow shams
- curtains, tablecloths, napkins, runners, placemats

Hard Goods - Place in boxes labeled Hard Goods (size restriction: 18”x18”x18”)

- small sporting goods/small garden tools
- small electrical items toasters, radio, power tools, irons, blenders, mixers, stereos/CD players
- housewares: china cups, vases, dishes, cutlery, mugs, pots, pans, candles, utensils, glassware, silverware, stemware, baskets

- small household goods and pictures/frames
- Small holiday decor - ornaments, items 18x18x18
- Toys, games, puzzles, stuffed animals
- Jewelry, craft items

Books – hard/ soft cover, music (CD and Vinyl) comics, magazines and electronic games. Place in boxes labeled books.

Cannot Accept List: water damaged or moldy items; make-up and personal toiletries; hazardous materials batteries, paints, chemicals, cleaning products; infant car seats, cribs and restricted by law.
